

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting
of the Prince Edward County Committee
of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Prince Edward County Committee of the Republican Party, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, John C. Marsden, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at 45 Simpson Road, Prospect, VA 23960, or its alternate location, starting at 10:00a.m. local time on March 18, 2023 for the following purposes:

- 1) Elect up to 85 Delegates and an equal number of alternates to the 10th Senate District Convention.

The 10th Senate District Convention will be held on May 6, 2023 beginning at 10:30 AM at: Buckingham County High School, 78 Knights Road, Buckingham, Virginia 23921 or an alternate site if necessary for the following purposes:

- a) Election of Republican Nominee for the Senate of Virginia 10th District, and
- b) Transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Delegate Vote per 250 Republican votes for Governor and President at their last election, so that Prince Edward County is entitled to 17 Delegate Votes;

- 2) and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the mass meeting.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

All legal and qualified voters of Prince Edward County, residing within the Farmville, West End, Center, Buffalo Heights or Prospect Precincts, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

MILITARY MEMBERS AS DELEGATES

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) may be certified as delegates by complying with the procedures detailed in a Unit's call pursuant to Article VIII, Section H, Paragraph 6 of the Plan of Organization of the Republican Party of Virginia. Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots.

Candidate preference ballots will be made available by the 10th Senate District Republican Committee no later than April 8, 2023 and will be made available on the Republican Party of Virginia website or upon request by e-mail to reatwilliams@gmail.com. Candidate preference ballots must be received no later than April 26, 2023, by physical delivery, postmarks will not govern, to R. T. “Torrey” Williams, III at P.O. Box 1787, 202 W. Main Street, Louisa, Virginia 23093.

FILING REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for election as convention delegates at said mass meeting shall file a Delegate Form by e-mail or in person, to Cindy Koether, Secretary, Prince Edward County Republican Committee, at ckoether@hsc.edu, or 664 Old Ridge Road, Farmville, VA 23901 which must be received not later than 7:00pm on March 11, 2023. Should no more than 85 candidates for convention delegate file then such candidates shall be deemed elected and the mass meeting shall be cancelled.
